VINIFICATION

Les Gravières is a broad climat of 29.46 ha. Its name speaks for itself, the soil is rich in gravel and limestone from the Combe de Saint-Aubin. The Domaine Jessiaume is the largest owner of Gravières. The plot is historic for the domaine.

After sorting in the vineyard and winery, the grapes are de-stemmed then directly put in tank. The spontaneous fermentation then starts. The grapes will stay in tank for roughly 3 weeks during alcoholic fermentation. The wine is then put in oak barrels (no new oak), by gravity, for 12 months.



TASTING NOTES

The color is ruby red of medium intensity. The nose is delicate on fresh red fruits with a hint of clove. The mouth is a bit tight but round.
