## VINIFICATION

The Clos Genet is a climat of 8.23 ha. It comes from the family of the same name. The particularity of the Domaine Jessiaume plot lies in the fact that its vines are enclosed within a Clos separated from the rest of Clos Genet. It is therefore called Clos du Clos Genet.

After sorting in the vineyard and winery, the grapes are de-stemmed then directly put in tank. The spontaneous fermentation then starts. The grapes will stay in tank for roughly 3 weeks during alcoholic fermentation. The wine is then put in oak barrels, by gravity, for 12 months (no new oak).



## TASTING NOTES

Ruby red color. The nose is marked by red fruits of cherry and raspberry. The mouth is elegant and structured with soft tannins.
