VINIFICATION

Les Perrières is a vineyard located in the village of Chassey-Le-Camp on the edge of Santenay. The plot is on a hillside with a north-east exposure giving it all its freshness and energy. The lower part is planted with Pinot Noir and the upper part, which contains more limestone, with Chardonnay.

After sorting in the vineyard and cellar, the grapes are destemmed and then directly vatted. Spontaneous fermentation then begins, followed by a 3-week cuvaison. The wine is then aged in oak barrels for 10 months (0% new wood). No fining is carried out.



TASTING NOTES

The wine has a beautiful medium purple color. Perfectly balanced with fresh, bright red fruit. The tannins are light and soft, and the acidity is seductive.
